JDI's transparent interface technology Rælclear was recognized in the Ministry of Internal Affairs and Communications in <u>Good Practices of Digital Accessibility 2023</u>, which recognizes products and services that excel in information accessibility.



Effective communication while being able to observe facial expressions



Facilitating communication between different languages

The Ministry of Internal Affairs and Communications recognized JDI for its efforts to break down communication barriers such as difficulties in hearing and communicating in different languages. JDI developed Rælclear taking into consideration valuable input from the hard of hearing and potential users from early on in the process.

Rælclear's key feature is its high transparency and the ability to fully and clearly view images and text from both sides. By placing a Rælclear device between two people, Rælclear can be used as an audio transcription and/or translation system, allowing users to read the transcribed text of the conversation while still being able to see the other person's facial expressions and gestures through the screen. This feature has been highly praised as a communication aid for the hard of hearing, APD/LiD¹ patients, and the elderly. It has also received high praise for its use in communication between speakers of varying languages.

¹ APD/LiD refers to symptoms that make it difficult to hear and understand speech as words.

Rælclear currently has the below use cases, and JDI continues to engage with many companies and groups to further expand its use. JDI believes that companies exist to serve society, and will continue to work towards serving as many people as possible via expanding the Rælclear install base.

Current Rælclear Use Cases and Installed Base

Administrative welfare offices for disabled persons, international exchange/support offices, reception desks and classrooms at schools for the deaf, daily activities of organizations for the hard of hearing, business use by hard of hearing employees in companies and organizations, hotel front desks and station counters, municipalities accepting Ukrainian refugees and the Ukrainian embassy.
