JDI is proposing amending Article 22 and Article 35 to align with the new management structure, and revising Article 11-5 and Article 11-6 for greater clarity.

  - For Proposal No. 1, shareholders representing no less than one-third (1/3) of total exercisable voting rights must be in attendance, and no less than two-thirds (2/3) of votes cast must be in favor of the proposal.
  - For Proposal No. 2, shareholders representing no less than one-third (1/3) of total exercisable voting rights must be in attendance, and no less than two-thirds (2/3) of votes cast must be in favor of the proposal.
  - For Proposal No. 3, shareholders representing no less than one-third (1/3) of total exercisable voting rights must be in attendance, and a majority of votes cast must be in favor of the proposal.

#### 4. Reason Why a Portion of AGM Votes Are Not Included in Votes Cast

The For Votes and Against Votes exercised before the AGM and confirmed at the AGM fulfilled the requirements for all of the proposals to be approved. Thus, votes at the AGM that could not be confirmed as either For Votes or Against Votes were not added to Votes Cast at the AGM.
