**Notice of the Impact of Torrential Rain in Kanto and Tohoku Regions
(Second Announcement, Production Resumption at the Mobara Plant)**

Japan Display Inc. ("JDI") would like to express our sympathy to the victims of torrential rain in the Kanto and Tohoku regions on Friday, October 25, and we hope for the hasty recovery of the areas affected by the rain.

The impact of the torrential rain on JDI, following the first report on Saturday, October 26, is as follows.

1. Status of impact

As announced on October 26, JDI's Mobara Plant (Mobara City, Chiba Prefecture) had suspended glass substrate starts since 6:00 a.m. on October 26 due to power shut down of the gas supply facilities caused by the torrential rain. However, the gas supply resumed at approximately 1:00 a.m. today with restoration of power supply to the gas supply facilities and completion of facility inspections, allowing the Plant to gradually resume production.

2. Impact on financial performance

The impact of this incident to our financial performance is under review. JDI will promptly announce any matters that should be disclosed.
